

# Utah Driver License Division

Reports on a person's driving record (also known as a Motor Vehicle Record or MVR) shall be released by the Utah Driver License Division to requestors who qualify under the permissible uses of the Driver Privacy Protection Act (DPPA).

---

## How to obtain a copy of your own driving record (MVR) in-person:

1. Fill out form DLD60 for a regular driving record.
2. Visit one of our driver's license offices or administrative offices and pay \$8.00 fee to the examiner.

## How to obtain a copy of your own driving record online:

1. Visit the website <https://secure.utah.gov/mvr-personal/>
2. "Request New Record"
3. Fill out your information and pay the fee.

## How to obtain a driving record (MVR) for someone other than yourself:

Note: you must qualify under the permissible uses outlined in DPPA.

1. Fill out form DLD60b.
  - a. The driver's signature needs to be notarized, so don't let them sign it until they are in front of a notary.
2. Visit one of our driver's license offices or administrative office.
3. Present the examiner the completed, notarized, form DLD60b and pay fee to the examiner.
